4) Vector Communications – North/South MetroLink Expansion

- a) www.northsidesouthsidestl.com
- b) Reviewed 2017 Northside-Southside study and provided a map of the proposed route
- c) The new line would operate on street level and utilize an open station plan without barriers. This would be similar to most modern rail projects
- d) Stations along Jefferson Avenue would hopefully encourage investment and vitality in their neighborhoods. The nearest proposed stations are Sidney, Arsenal and Cherokee
- e) The \$700 million expansion would be partially supported by Proposition 1, which recently passed. The government may offer a 100% match
- Benton Park West residents expressed concerns about security, traffic and park-and-ride options
